Li Binyuan was born in 1985 in Yongzhou, Hunan, China and graduated from the Sculpture Department of the Central Academy of Fine Arts in 2011. His works have been exhibited in the United States, Europe and Asia and are included in the permanent collections of the Museum of Modern Art (MoMA) in New York and the M+ Museum for Visual Culture in Hong Kong, among others.

Li Binyuan explores the body, materiality, perceptions and social values through actions, videos and performances that delve into different areas of everyday society. His practice occupies both urban and rural spaces, including public spaces, natural environments or remote post-industrial areas; he uses the body as a sculptural material for creative research, as well as rupture and repetition to show how sculpture and performance are intertwined; re-establishing social behaviours while examining our daily experiences. His awards include the Award of Merit at the Inward Gazes - Documentaries of Chinese Performance Art (2015), a Gold Key Nomination at the 37th Kassel Documentary Film Festival (2020), the 14th AAC Art China Young Artist of the Year Award (2020), the 17th Sovereign Outstanding Asian Art Grand Prize (2021), the Artist of the Year Award at Today Art Museum's Reshape - WSK Art Prize & TAM Nominated Emerging Artists Exhibition (2021).
