Tan Jing (b. 1992, Shenzhen) lives and works between Jingdezhen and Shenzhen.

She mainly works with sculptures and multi-media installations. By employing olfactory substances, fibres, glass, and artificial mucus, with a whimsical intertwist of personal history, biology, folklore, and surreal elements, Tan explores how in a site-specific context the senses are aroused by experimental materials, achieving an overlap of individual experiences and semi-fictional stories. She uses objects to create scenarios of the surreal within the space, striking the viewer aesthetically and psychologically, making visible and sensible the trauma and solitude of individuals in societies. Her works have been shown internationally in institutions such as Rockbund Art Museum, Shanghai; HB Station, Guangzhou; X Museum, Beijing; Para Site, Hong Kong; Guangdong Times Museum, Guangzhou; Spielzeug Welten Museum, Basel; Camden Art Centre project, London, and among others.
